URGENT MOTION

Jobs cutting at the RTVE

Tabled by SJP (Portugal), FNSI (Italy), SNJ and SNJ-CGT (France)

The Annual Meeting of the EFJ, gathered in Bled on April 8th 2006,

- Noting the decision taken by the Spanish public Radio and Television (RTVE) to cut the employment by 3133 jobs;
- Recognising that a cut by 39% in the employment of RTVE will not allow the RTVE to fulfil its mission of public service;
- Meaning that the RTVE's debt is a consequence of its under-financing by the Spanish government

Expresses

- Its solidarity with the employed persons by the RTVE in their struggle to oppose this plan of jobs cut.

Requests

- The Steering Committee and the EFJ member unions to send solidarity messages to the RTVE's trade unions;
- The EFJ Steering Committee to consider to send a delegation to Spain, and to instruct this delegation to meet the Spanish public authorities condemning this plan which is supported by all European journalists
- The EFJ member unions to promote the RTVE's commitment to a strong public service broadcasting.
